

You might qualify for assistance on your monthly Internet Bill.

The EBBP (Emergency Broadband Benefit Program) is an FCC program to help households struggling to pay for Internet service during the pandemic. According to acting FCC Chairwoman Jessica Rosenworcel, "We need to use all available tools to get 100% of us connected in the country and this program is an essential part of making that happen."

Although final details of the program have not been released at the time of GBT's May newsletter, households that think they might qualify for this program can get updates and receive additional information on the FCC website fcc.gov/broadbandbenefit. The program through the FCC will provide a discount of up to \$50 per month towards broadband service for eligible households until funding has been exhausted. Below is a list of criteria that determines eligibility for this program which also can be found on the FCC website.

Who Is Eligible for the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program?

A household is eligible if one member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Qualifies for the Lifeline program;
- Receives benefits under the free and reducedprice school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision, or did so in the 2019-2020 school year;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Experienced a substantial loss of income since February 29, 2020 and the household had a total income in 2020 below \$99,000 for single filers and \$198,000 for joint filers; or
- Heets the eligibility criteria for a participating providers' existing low-income or COVID-19 program.

GBT wants our customers to be aware of this program and know we will be a participating Internet provider. GBT is not responsible for the administering or funding of this program, but will adhere to and follow the guidelines and eligibility of qualifying households set forth by the FCC.
