Purpose

- Must attend 6 of the 6 scheduled meetings to receive full scholarship of \$750. One missed meeting will reduce your scholarship to \$500. Two or more missed meetings & you will be ineligible for scholarship.
- Communicate appropriately to GBT staff if unable to attend.
- Each Jr. Board Member will be required to help with a coordinated youth event.
- Each Jr. Board Member will be required to attend the 2020 GBT Annual Meeting (date TBA)
