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YOUTH TOUR *Frequently Asked Questions*

Q: Who may take part in the FRS Youth Tour?

A: Any high school student, age 16 or 17 years old at the time of the Youth Tour. FRS will NOT accept any student 18 years of age and over – no exceptions will be made. Students must receive service from a current National Telecommunications Cooperative Association (NTCA) member company such as GBT.

Q: What if I will be 18 at the time of the Youth Tour?

A: Students who are 18 years or older at the time of the Youth Tour will NOT be permitted to attend. No Exceptions will be made.

Q: What does the registration fee cover and who is responsible for paying it?

A: The registration fee of \$1,075 is paid for by GBT. It covers all Washington D.C. based expenses, including: four nights at the Doubletree Hotel in Crystal City, VA, three meals a day, bus transportation to all activities, admission to ticketed events, special entertainment, airport greeting and transportation, gratuities, Youth Tour t-shirt, student yearbook, student dance with DJ, and all supplies/materials.

Q: Are there any expenses I have to pay?

A: Not really. GBT covers the cost of airfare. *However, students are required to find their own source of transportation to the airport.* GBT will communicate to selected individuals about their wishes coordinating travel. In addition, \$50 will be given to the student to be used for souvenirs and any other incidentals. Students may bring additional money with them if they choose.

Q: When is the deadline for me to apply?

A: GBT must receive your completed application and essay no later than March 16th, 2020. The 2020 delegates will be selected and announced no later than March 31st, 2020.

Q: Would I be responsible for making my flight arrangements?

A: No. GBT will take care of the registration as well as travel itinerary. Please note that all students and chaperones are required to fly from Kansas City (MCI) into and out of Reagan National Airport (DCA).
